PRIZES

- Prizes for official 1st and 2nd placed foursomes
- **Major prize draw** (reverse raffle – 50% weighting to 1st place on the day)
- 8 nights accommodation in a 4 bedroom private house near ANGC
- 2 x Tee times at leading golf courses on Monday and Tuesday
- 4 x Tickets to the Wednesday 'Par 3' Practice Day
- 4 x Patrons Badges to the US Masters for Thursday thru Sunday
- Access to Elite Sporting Tours BBQs during the week
- Flights and travel to Augusta, Georgia are not included in the package

COST

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Each person must have an official handicap at an approved (by Elite Sporting Tours) Australian Golf Club as at the date of entry
- The handicap applicable for the golf day cannot be higher than as at 1 August 2010 but can be lower
- Maximum handicap allowed will be 18. Golfers with a handicap higher than 18 are welcome
- All entrants will provide applicable Golf Australia approved (and Golfink) handicap details upon entry
- No more than one Kingston Heath Golf Club member may play in any one group
- No one who is a professional golfer or has been a professional golfer in the past may enter
- All persons eligible for the major prize draw must be over 21 years of age
- Elite Sporting Tours reserves the right to postpone if all 18 tee spots are not filled
- Entries close 31 October 2010

CONDITIONS OF MAJOR PRIZE DRAW

- The Major Prize has a market value of cUS\$50,000 – **Amateur status will not be affected** given the format of the Major Prize draw below (reverse raffle and element of luck)
- The Major Prize must be used in 2012 by at least 2 of the 4 players who won the prize
- Elite Sporting Tours reserves the right to approve any changes to personnel using the Major Prize

FORMAT OF MAJOR PRIZE DRAW

- The draw will be a “reverse raffle” draw, with the winner being the final ball remaining in the draw out of 100 balls to start with - the 100 balls will be allocated as follows based on positions in the tournament:

FORMAT OF TOURNAMENT

- The tournament will be a “shot gun” start, with each group starting on a different hole (18 groups total)
- Each groups starting hole will be done determined by an ‘independent draw’ to allocate groups – Hole #1 (and possibly others – ie #7) will be auctioned off with all proceeds going to The Ponting Foundation
- KHGC will be set up reflecting as close to Australian Masters format as practicable (back members tees)
- At the completion of each hole, the 3 best nett stroke scores will be recorded on the score card. Elite Sporting Tours will have a representative with each group to cross check and report the scores
- A rules official will be available for any necessary rulings. The Elite Sporting Tours representative allocated to each group will contact the Rules Official if and when required
- Nett stroke is determined by total strokes on the hole, reduced for any applicable handicap on that hole as determined by the stroke index on the score card
- At the conclusion of 18 holes, the winning team will be the team with the lowest total nett stoke score for the full 18 holes
- In the event of a playoff (only for places 1st, 2nd and 3rd), the tied teams will nominate 2 players to compete on their behalf in an aggregate nett stroke per hole playoff, beginning at hole 1 and continuing until a winner is determined
